Lighty also took his fair share of wickets this season and in the future Derek, always believe in your own ability. You were a real weapon for the team this season. Rowan just got better with every game he played and proved this by taking 5 wickets in the semi final; I really look forward to watching him grow into a great player for Warradale. Caddy shack bowled well but without much luck for the season and I hope he will come back to correct that next season. Sido played his 100th game for the club this season. A great effort mate, well done from everyone at the club and especially me.

In closing I want to say a big thank you to my two super subs for the season Hux & Trinity, even though you guys didn't make it easy for me as captain we definitely could not have gone as far as we did this season without you both.
