

## B GRADE CAPTAIN'S REPORT

2016/17 was the most satisfying for me as captain without doubt. We finished the minor round with 8 wins (including 1 outright), 4 losses and 2 draws. We were undefeated at Xmas, but this was due to us pulling off 3 miracle wins against St George, North Haven & Mitchell Park. Late in each of these matches, we looked like we were going to lose, but we hung in there, kept persisting and believing, and were eventually rewarded for maintaining our concentration and endeavour for 100% of the match, not just the first 95%.

This year the B's went down to section 5 due to the 7+7 fixture, so the belief was there from the start that we could achieve the ultimate success. However, this belief was substantially reinforced and increased by those hard attritional wins in the first half of the season, and this match hardness came to the fore in the Grand Final when we restricted Mitchell Park to just 120 runs off 60 overs.

Our team was forced to evolve over the course of the season, due to losing key players to the A grade. To cover these losses, we introduced Chris Benson, Mark Burrows and Bill Hansberry to the side, and all showed all-rounder qualities. We also had to deal with late season injuries to Ivan Juric, Chris Benson & Ash Marshall. It was remarkable that we achieved what we did, considering the setbacks along the way.

Paul Temby won this year's batting trophy with 428 runs @ 71.3 in just 6 innings, with 2 centuries, smacked 26 sixes and 47 fours, and was the key factor in 3 of our wins before Xmas.

Ash Marshall won our bowling trophy with 33 wickets @ 13.9, including 11 wickets in a match (a club record) in our outright win against South Road. He also scored 260 runs before injury ended his season a week before the finals.

Chip Tonkin delivered in a big way with 20 wickets @ 16.2 and played an outstanding role in his match winning partnership with Daisy Brusnahan in a club record run chase against North Haven. So Chip wins the B grade Captain's Trophy.

Ash Marshall, a big thankyou to you for being my Vice Captain, and also to Dave Palmer for filling the void.
